Combined with a readily available and inexpensive macro lens (In the picture, the iPhone is equipped with an olloclip® macro lens.), AlpVision's authentication application works with an image magnified ten times, taken at a distance of approximately 12-15 mm. By capturing the finest structure nuances of the foil, AlpVision's authentication application allows brand owners, manufacturers and experts to verify the authenticity of blister packs in less than 3 seconds. This quick-connect, light-weight solution is ideally suited to perform fast and highly-reliable verifications at the manufacturing facility or in the field.

AlpVision Completes Successful Exhibition at Imaging Supplies Coalition Anti-Counterfeiting Conference in Las Vegas

AlpVision participated in the Imaging Supplies Coalition (ISC) 14th International Anti-Counterfeiting Conference held on August 19 through 21 in Las Vegas, NV. The conference was attended by approximately 75 industry specialists and coalition members, including Brother, Canon, Dell, Epson, HP, Lexmark, Toshiba, and Xerox. Speaking on "Digital Solutions for Imaging Supplies Protection," Mr. Quincy Mattingly, Regional Manager, introduced a covert, multilayer brand protection solution for packaging, toner, inkjet cartridges, and batteries detectable using a scanner or iPhone. He explained how brand owners could use their own consumables and existing printing equipment to protect their products against counterfeiting. Discussions made clear that protecting imaging supplies is a critical issue.
